## History

### **Stone Age**

**Beliefs:** Stone Age/Bronze Age/Iron Age beliefs - animal spirits, hunting ceremonies and burial rituals. Neolithic tombs and burials in long barrows.

**Conflict:** Rivalry between tribes. The construction of hill forts.  
**Settlement:** Changes from the cave dwellings of the Palaeolithic period to the houses of the Mesolithic and Neolithic period e.g. Skara Brae. **Bronze and Iron Age** settlements

**Society:** Changes from a nomadic, hunter-gatherer society to a farming society. The development of metal, woven wool, trade.
