### **Online Safety**

Can we remind parents to monitor their children's online usage, not only apps that they are accessing but also who they are engaging with online. Parents need to be vigilant to safeguard their own children. Many of our children talk about games or apps that have an age rating of 12+ or 13+, this includes games such as Fortnite and apps such as TikTok.

As we approach the Christmas season, when children may be getting new devices or have more time on devices, we wish to give you some tips as to how you can keep your child safer online:

- Keep your child's computer or console in an area where you can monitor what they are doing online. Not only what they are accessing but also what they are saying to other people online and what other people are saying to them.
- Check your child's browser history frequently.
- Use parental controls to limit what your child can access.
- Know your children's passwords.
- Know all of the computers or devices that your child can use.
- Only allow children on age appropriate apps and social media. Most social media apps have an age rating of 13+, this includes TikTok, Snapchat and Instagram.
- If you hear racist or homophobic comments online, you can (and should) report this to the police as a hate crime or to the online gaming platform.

## Arbor

Thank you for signing up to Arbor our new communication tool. The office staff are becoming more familiar with it and there are a number of other features, which we will be rolling out in January. We will be setting up payments for breakfast and afterschool club, dinners, milk, trips and clubs. **Please don't add any monies to Parent Pay.**

## PE Kits and Swimming

We will continue children coming to school in their PE kit on the days when they have PE (for all year groups). Children will not need their uniform in school on those days.

On PE days children should wear full PE kit

- PE kits: all-black trainers (see uniform reminder below), black or white sport socks, navy jogging bottoms (in colder weather) or shorts (summer), white PE t-shirt, sports jacket or school sweatshirt.
- No jewellery
- No branded items of clothing to be worn e.g. Nike
